Set in a quiet leafy crescent in the exclusive West End of Edinburgh, only minutes from the main attractions, The Bonham provides guests with luxurious rooms and suites. Many rooms offer stunning views either over Drumsheugh Gardens or towards the Firth of Forth and the Kingdom of Fife.

Welcoming lounges and a stylish restaurant and bar make the most of the beautiful interiors of the original houses and look over the peaceful gardens.

Within a 10 minute walk of The Bonham Hotel you will reach the bustling shopping area of Princes Street, with many big name high street stores along with great views of Edinburgh Castle and Princes Street Gardens or turn on to upmarket George Street which is full of luxury restaurants, cocktail bars and designer shops.

A leisurely 20 minute walk from The Bonham and you will be in Edinburgh's Old Town, a labyrinth of cobbled streets, narrow alleyways and hidden courtyards, all amazingly well preserved and steeped in the city's history. At its centre is the Royal Mile, a remarkable street of reformation-era tenement buildings leading from the seat of Edinburgh Castle down to the grandiose Palace of Holyrood.

The Bonham is only a 20-minute taxi transfer from Edinburgh Airport or use the city tram network from the Airport to Haymarket station, a 10-minute walk or 5-minute taxi to the Bonham.

THE HISTORY OF THE BONHAM

The buildings The Bonham now occupy have a fascinating history dating back to the mid-19th century and were originally constructed as 3 separate townhouses in 1872.

The houses were occupied by well to do families and their servants for the next 60 years, enjoying the privacy of Drumsheugh Gardens and the ease of access to everything Edinburgh had to offer.

In 1939 the houses were sold and became collectively known as the “Private Clinic”, a private medical practice specialising in maternity care. Over the next 12 years many hundreds of babies were born on the premises, now fondly known as “Bonham Babies” when they come to visit.

1951 saw the sale of the Private Clinic to the University of Edinburgh who converted the buildings into Muir Hall of Residence for university students from outside the city.

Following the sale of Muir Hall the Bonham Hotel opened in 1998 as one of the first boutique hotels in the city. Following an extensive renovation in 2018 the hotel now offers guests one of the best places to stay in Edinburgh and is still true to the original aspiration of providing a homely and friendly base whilst visiting Edinburgh.



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
